

Class Atlantis Maths: we are learning about shape this term.

Circle Follow-up Activities

Remind your child by showing them one or several circular objects eg a plastic plate, lids etc and saying "circle". If your child wishes to, encourage them to touch the circular objects.

Explain that you are going to look around to see if you can find more circles. This can be done inside the house or outside on a walk. If you wish, you or your child can take photos of some or all of the circles you see; these can be used to remind your child after your walk, or to count how many circles you found, or can be printed out to make a collage of circles.



This can be done once or you can spot circles on several of your walks over the week.

As an additional follow-up activity, why not make up a sensory tray (using oats, shaving foam etc or water) and put in some of the plastic circular objects you found around the house for your child to explore.
